



## Programming & Digital Literacy

At a time when technology is rapidly evolving and has become an integral part of our lives, knowledge of basic programming skills is now more than essential. Taking that need into account, the Tipping Point, supported by Kotsovolos, enabled students from 10 schools in Crete to participate in sessions dedicated to the thematic section of “Programming & Digital Literacy”.

At the same time, students received credentials to make use of the first e-learning platform for code learning in Greek, Kode, through which they had the opportunity to acquire basic code skills in three categories:

- Design your website
- Design your application
- Design your game

The aim of the project was to highlight the need to learn the practical dimensions of the basic principles and applications of Programming regarding young people’s interest and needs, as well as to reconcile themselves with the code that will enable them to excel in the areas of their choice.
