In the region of Prespes, young people used the Tipping Point program in a unique way. Junior High school (2nd + 3rd grade) and High school (1st grade) students learned about Oceanography, the everyday life of a Researcher, Theater, and Robotics by “meeting” mentors, not in their classrooms but in the Public Library of Prespes.

Every Saturday night, students gathered, in order to participate in sessions that have been planned by them. At the end of each session, they discussed and scheduled the next one and set the questions of the agenda for next week.
